Enclosed you will find important information about our 2020 season, and how to order season tickets. Please note the important dates and deadlines below. We want to make sure we honor our faithful supporters, while also reaching new audiences. *We look forward to your support in 2020!*

Exchanges

As a season ticket holder, you have the privilege of exchanging your tickets for another performance night. Those who wish to exchange tickets must contact CAST prior to opening night. Once a show has opened, ticket exchanges will not be accepted. We recommend contacting CAST early to exchange tickets. We will work with you to get the best possible seats available.

Refunds

Refunds will not be given for any CAST events.

Filling Season Ticket Orders

We will begin filling season ticket orders on November 1, guaranteeing those who currently have season tickets the same seats for the same performance night as this year. But we can only guarantee this through November 1. Get your orders in early and before November 1 to guarantee your same seats. Order forms can be mailed to CAST, or dropped off at the CAST office on Mondays from 5:30-6:30.

We will fill new season ticket orders November 1-15. Season tickets will be available on our website, and to the general public, November 15 at noon. After this date, all season ticket orders will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Don't wait!

Ticketing Hours

- The CAST office will be open most Mondays 5:30-6:30.
- The Box Office is open 30 minutes before each performance.
- Season tickets can be purchased online at www.ClearfieldArts.org/tickets beginning November 15 at noon.
- Tickets will be sold online and at the CAST office four weeks before opening night of each production.

Disney's Alladin Jr.


February 27-29, March 5-7 at 7:30 p.m. | Adults \$12; Students \$10

He clashes with the head nurse. He quickly takes over the yard and accomplishes what the medical profession has been unable to do for twelve years; he makes a presumed deaf and dumb Indian talk. He leads others out of introversion, stages a revolt so that they can see the World Series on television, and arranges a rollicking midnight party with liquor and chippies. Director TBA.



Shrek The Musical

July 9-11, 16-18 at 7:30 p.m. | Tickets \$15

Based on the Oscar-winning DreamWorks Animation film, Shrek The Musical is a Tony Award- winning fairy tale adventure. "Once upon a time, there was a little ogre named Shrek..." And thus begins the tale of an unlikely hero who finds himself on a life-changing journey alongside a wisecracking Donkey and a feisty princess who resists her rescue. Throw in a short-tempered bad guy, a cookie with an attitude, and over a dozen other fairy tale misfits, and you've got the kind of mess that calls for a real hero. Luckily, there's one on hand, and his name is Shrek. Irreverently fun for the whole family, Shrek proves that beauty is truly in the eye of the ogre. Directed by Lew Duttry.

Steel Magnolias

September 10-12, 17-19 at 7:30 p.m. | Adults \$12; Students \$10

The action is set in Truvy's beauty salon in Chinquapin, Louisiana, where all the ladies who are "anybody" come to have their hair done. Helped by her eager new assistant, Annelle, the outspoken, wise-cracking Truvy dispenses shampoos and free advice to the town's rich curmudgeon, Ouiser; an eccentric millionaire, Miss Clairee, who has a raging sweet tooth; and the local social leader, M'Lynn, whose daughter, Shelby, is about to marry a "good ole boy." A sudden realization of their mortality affects them all , but also draws on the underlying strength—and love—which give the play, and its characters, the special quality to make them truly touching, funny and marvelously amiable company in good times and bad.
